

Counting Coins

Grade 2 • MATH • Counting money: pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters • Standards: 2.MD.C.8

Count the coins in each piggy bank and write the total amount with a cent sign (¢). You can do it!

1. Piggy bank has: 3 pennies. How much money is in the piggy bank?
2. Piggy bank has: 1 nickel. How much money is in the piggy bank?
3. Piggy bank has: 1 dime. How much money is in the piggy bank?
4. Piggy bank has: 1 nickel and 2 pennies. How much money is in the piggy bank?
5. Piggy bank has: 1 dime and 3 pennies. How much money is in the piggy bank?
6. Piggy bank has: 2 nickels. How much money is in the piggy bank?
7. Piggy bank has: 1 quarter. How much money is in the piggy bank?
8. Piggy bank has: 1 dime and 2 nickels. How much money is in the piggy bank?
9. Piggy bank has: 1 quarter and 1 nickel. How much money is in the piggy bank?
10. Piggy bank has: 2 dimes and 4 pennies. How much money is in the piggy bank?
11. Piggy bank has: 1 quarter, 1 dime, and 1 nickel. How much money is in the piggy bank?
12. Piggy bank has: 1 quarter, 2 dimes, 1 nickel, and 3 pennies. How much money is in the piggy bank?

Answer Key — Counting Coins

For the teacher / parent. Do not distribute with the worksheet.

1. 3¢ (*3 pennies = 3¢*)
2. 5¢ (*1 nickel = 5¢*)
3. 10¢ (*1 dime = 10¢*)
4. 7¢ (*5¢ + 2¢ = 7¢*)
5. 13¢ (*10¢ + 3¢ = 13¢*)
6. 10¢ (*5¢ + 5¢ = 10¢*)
7. 25¢ (*1 quarter = 25¢*)
8. 20¢ (*10¢ + 5¢ + 5¢ = 20¢*)
9. 30¢ (*25¢ + 5¢ = 30¢*)
10. 24¢ (*10¢ + 10¢ + 4¢ = 24¢*)
11. 40¢ (*25¢ + 10¢ + 5¢ = 40¢*)
12. 53¢ (*25¢ + 10¢ + 10¢ + 5¢ + 3¢ = 53¢*)
