Grade 3 • MATH • Rounding to the nearest 10 and 100 • Standards: 3.NBT.A.1

Round each number to the place shown. Remember: if the digit is 5 or more, round up!

1. Round 32 to the nearest 10.
2. Round 78 to the nearest 10.
3. Round 45 to the nearest 10.
4. Round 91 to the nearest 10.
5. Round 200 to the nearest 100.
6. Round 136 to the nearest 10.
7. Round 420 to the nearest 100.
8. Round 287 to the nearest 10.
9. Round 650 to the nearest 100.
10. Round 374 to the nearest 100.
11. Round 549 to the nearest 10.
12. Round 815 to the nearest 100.
13. Round 463 to the nearest 10 and to the nearest 100.
14. Round 728 to the nearest 10 and to the nearest 100.
15. Round 955 to the nearest 10 and to the nearest 100.

Answer Key — Rounding Round-Up

For the teacher / parent. Do not distribute with the worksheet.

1. 30 (*The ones digit is 2, which is less than 5, so round down to 30.*)
2. 80 (*The ones digit is 8, which is 5 or more, so round up to 80.*)
3. 50 (*The ones digit is 5, so round up to 50.*)
4. 90 (*The ones digit is 1, which is less than 5, so round down to 90.*)
5. 200 (*200 is already a multiple of 100, so it stays 200.*)
6. 140 (*The ones digit is 6, which is 5 or more, so round up to 140.*)
7. 400 (*The tens digit is 2, which is less than 5, so round down to 400.*)
8. 290 (*The ones digit is 7, which is 5 or more, so round up to 290.*)
9. 700 (*The tens digit is 5, so round up to 700.*)
10. 400 (*The tens digit is 7, which is 5 or more, so round up to 400.*)
11. 550 (*The ones digit is 9, which is 5 or more, so round up to 550.*)
12. 800 (*The tens digit is 1, which is less than 5, so round down to 800.*)
13. 460 and 500 (*For nearest 10: ones digit is 3, round down to 460. For nearest 100: tens digit is 6, round up to 500.*)
14. 730 and 700 (*For nearest 10: ones digit is 8, round up to 730. For nearest 100: tens digit is 2, round down to 700.*)
15. 960 and 1000 (*For nearest 10: ones digit is 5, round up to 960. For nearest 100: tens digit is 5, round up to 1000.*)
